

Administrator Guide: Academic Teaching License or Community and Technical College License

Overview

This guide, for administrators only, describes how to link the **Academic Teaching License** or **Community and Technical College License** to student and faculty MathWorks Accounts. These license offerings provide access to MathWorks products for faculty and students on personal and college-owned computers. In this guide, the term *users* encompasses faculty and students.

Link License to User Accounts

Before a user can access MathWorks products, they must be added to the license by a license administrator. This process automatically links the license to the user's MathWorks Account (any user who does not have an account will have one created for them).

To add one or more users to the license, follow these steps:

- 1. Go to License Center.
- 2. Select the organization's MATLAB license and navigate to the **Manage Users** tab.
- 3. Click **Add/Remove Users** to add either a single user or a list of users. A .CSV file with first name, last name, and school (or preferred) email address is required to add a list of users (template provided).

All added users receive email with instructions to take for their next step. As an added precaution, you might want to email users to let them know they have been added, in case the email from MathWorks goes to spam or trash.

Users on the license may download and install MathWorks products on their personal computers by following the *Install MATLAB on Personal Computers* instructions below.

Remove Users from License

You can remove individual users from a license using the License Center.

- 1. Go to License Center.
- Select the organization's MATLAB license.
- 3. Navigate to **Manage Users**.
- 4. Click **Add/Remove User** to remove a single user or a list of users. Individual users can also be removed by clicking "X" next to their name. A .CSV file with first name, last name, and school (or preferred) email address is required to remove a list of users (template provided).

The user no longer has access to the license.

Install MATLAB on Personal Computers

This workflow requires an internet connection.

Step 1. Download Product Installer

- Go to matlab.mathworks.com and sign in to the MathWorks Account that includes your institution's license.
- 2. Click Install MATLAB.
- 3. Click **Download** for the current release.
- 4. Choose a supported platform and then download the installer.

Step 2. Install MathWorks Products

1. Run the MathWorks Product Installer.

- 2. Sign in and follow the installer prompts.
- 3. At **Select license**, select the license labeled MATLAB.
- 4. At **Select products**, check the products to download, and then click **Next**.
- 5. Confirm your selections and then click **Begin Install**.
- 6. When the installation is complete, click **Finish**.

Access Online Training

After users have been linked to a license, they are automatically enrolled in self-paced online training courses included with the license.

Users who are new to MATLAB can learn the basics with Get Started with MATLAB.

Go to *matlab.mathworks.com* to view the courses under **Online Training**.

Access MATLAB on Shared Computers

The license offering provides two options for providing access to MATLAB for your users on shared computers.

Use MATLAB in a web browser

The license offering provides access to *MATLAB Online*, which allows use of MATLAB and Simulink through your web browser. MATLAB Online can be accessed by any internet-connected machine, personal or college-owned computers. The use of MATLAB Online on a shared computer, such as in labs or conference rooms, does not require any installation or configuration work.

To use *MATLAB Online* on one of the *supported browsers*, users sign in with their MathWorks Account.

Install MATLAB on Shared Computers

Alternatively, in situations where MATLAB Online cannot be used, the license offering also provides access to a Login Named User (LNU) configuration that allows MathWorks products to be installed on shared computers with an uninterrupted internet connection. With an LNU configuration on shared computers that have uninterrupted internet

connection, users are required to sign in to their MathWorks Account each time they start MATLAB.

To install MATLAB for Login Named User, perform the following steps:

- 1. Download ISO Image
- 2. Retrieve File Installation Key
- 3. Install Noninteractively

NOTE: To configure MATLAB for LNU, set enableLNU to "yes" in the installer properties file installer_input.txt.
